Cohort fellows receive a \$7,000 stipend.

Half of the stipend is disbursed after the start of the program and half at the end of the semester upon successful completion of the program.

Eligible students

- University of Arizona PhD candidate who has completed qualifying exams or master's student in a professional program.
- Pursuing a degree or research project related to environmental and societal resilience.
- Available to actively engage in weekly Tuesday and Thursday sessions during the Fall semester from 11:00 am–1:00 pm.
